

DRIVING IN WET WEATHER



- Slow down and increase your stopping distance.
- Use your lights if necessary to increase your ability to see and for others to see you.
- Avoid hard braking- standing water will reduce road surface friction.



- Take extra care around pedestrians, cyclist, motorcyclists and horses- slow down and give them extra room when passing.
- Stay Informed- Listen out for travel bulletins and look out for road warning signs about travel conditions ahead.
