

JUNCTION SAFETY



TIPS TO AVOID ACCIDENTS:

- Look out for pedestrians everywhere and at all times
- Keep bike lanes free
- Use extra caution in hard-to-see conditions (e.g. at night, bad weather, blind corners)
- Slow down, check mirrors and blind spots and be prepared to stop when turning
- Give way to pedestrians crossing or waiting to cross a road into which or from which you are turning. If they have started to cross they have priority, so give way
- Do not assume, when waiting at a junction, that a vehicle coming from the right and signalling left will actually turn. Wait and make sure
